- Comply with FWDC policies and procedures as outlined in the FWDC Subcontractor Handbook
- Remain in communication with FWDC staff
- Utilize organizational skills to stay prompt with deadlines
- Attend subcontractor meetings and trainings
- Work as a team player with FWDC subcontractors, staff, and volunteers

### **Required Qualifications:**

- Must be 25 years of age or older
- Bachelor's degree in an art field or demonstrated professional artistic experience
- Demonstrate a speciality in one or more of these art forms: literary arts and music
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Ability to plan and organize
- Excellent interpersonal and problem solving skills
- Displays high level of initiative and customer service

### **Hours:**

Part-time, subcontractor. 6.5 hours per week, which can be completed in one or two shifts. Schedule must be fairly consistent over the course of a calendar year.
